NOTICE IS GIVEN that we are applying to the Consistory Court of the diocese for permission to carry out the following:

Replacement of gas boiler comprising:

1. Disconnection of existing boiler and its removal from site
2. Fitting of a new Worcester-Bosch 30kw Greenstar Life 8000 A rated condensing boiler to the external wall in the boiler house stairwell with a new flue outlet emerging through that wall covered by a protective wire guard
3. Amendment and reconnection of heating and gas pipework to the new boiler, with a condensate discharge pump running behind cupboards in the vestry to the nearest drain using a condensate lift pump
4. Retention and connection of existing controls with frost protection to the new boiler
5. Fitting of a new Grundfoss circulation pump as part of the new boiler installation

### **Directions to petitioner**

You must display this public notice (or a copy of it) for a continuous period of not less than 28 days, not counting the day on which it was put up or the day on which it is taken down, (or for such other period as the Court may direct and subject to any special directions of the registrar) in each of the following places:

1. on a notice board or in some other prominent position inside the church; and
2. on a notice board outside the church or in some other prominent position (whether on the outside of the church door or elsewhere) so that it can be read by the public.
